ALPHA/BETA

A drama about a retired 30-year-old dominatrix who relies on her knowledge of money and power to reinvent herself in the high-risk world of venture capital.

RUTHLESS

After an accident leaves her disabled, an elderly trucker is reunited with her estranged family who team up to dismantle the local white supremacist crime ring.

RAGER

In this psychological thriller, a group of young millionaire friends drive to a beach mansion for a weekend of wild partying, but when the women in the group confront the men's abusive behavior, it turns into a deadly hunt for revenge.

THE MOD

A period dramedy about a young man obsessed with the British Mod movement who battles society's conservative values in his quest to become a famous musician during the 1960's counterculture revolution.

LUSTY GLANCES

A 1970s period comedy about over-the-top nightlife eccentrics caught in a Studio 54-esque disco soap opera, who inadvertantly solve key social issues.
